***2438** 15. List of U.S. Embassies Using DS-160 Online Form Expanded

The Department of State (DOS or Department) has reported that selected U.S. embassy and consulate locations are now using the new Form DS-160, Nonimmigrant Visa Electronic Application. The Form DS-160 is "a fully integrated online application form that will be used to collect the necessary application information from persons seeking a nonimmigrant visa," according to the information on the Department's forms website. The form can be accessed through <https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/>.

As of September 25, 2009, the following U.S. embassy and consulate locations are currently utilizing the Form DS-160:

- Melbourne, Perth, and Sydney, Australia;
- Hamilton, Bermuda; ***2439**
- Montreal and Vancouver, Canada;
- Hong Kong;
- Dublin, Ireland;
- Tripoli, Libya;
- Ciudad Juarez, Hermosillo, Matamoros, Monterrey, Nogales, and Nuevo Laredo, Mexico; and
- Podgorica, Montenegro.

The DOS suggests that customers check http://travel.state.gov/visa/frvi/forms/forms_4230.html for the addition of other locations as more U.S. embassies and consulates implement the new process.
